## Rifle & Pistol Range Rules

1. Any person using the range must be a current member and have their membership card or badge with them. Membership runs from January 1<sup>st</sup> to December 31<sup>st</sup>.
2. Everyone is responsible for safety.
3. NEVER POINT FIREARMS AT ANYONE! This includes when you place or remove firearms from the firing line.
4. All ranges are controlled by the amber light.
5. Amber light flashing: Cease-Fire, open actions, unload firearms, no handling of firearms and stand clear of the firing line.
6. Amber light turned off: All clear and commence firing. Everyone should ensure that down range is clear and safe. LOOK carefully between the targets.
7. Everyone shooting is responsible for making sure the amber light is used and everyone has a chance to post their target and take it down when they are finished shooting.

8. All firearms must be unloaded and actions shall remain open, except when in use on the range under when the amber light is off.
9. Hearing and eye protection is required when in the range building.
10. All targets must be placed on and fastened to the rubber target boards provided, inside the designated area only.
11. No targets are to be placed on top of the pipes or the stone walkway.
12. No shooting of exploding targets, glass, bowling pins, plastic jugs, cans, pumpkins, etc. PAPER TARGETS ONLY!!!
13. No tracer, armor piercing or steel core ammunition is to be used.
14. All targets are to be removed when you are finished shooting.
15. Clean up and dispose of your spent casing shells and trash.
16. Spent casings in front of the shooting area or benches should only be picked up during a SAFETY LIGHT.
17. All firing must be done from established firing lines inside the range building only.
18. Misfired ammunition: Treat with caution. Cartridges that fail to fire must NOT be disposed of anywhere on the grounds, including spent casing cans, trash barrel or

burning barrel. You are responsible for your own misfired ammunition.

19. A muzzleloader is considered unloaded when the powder has been spent from the barrel.
20. Never prime or cap a muzzleloader until reaching the firing line.
21. All 50 BMG and full automatic firearms are prohibited.
22. Food, beverages and smoking are prohibited on the range and in the range building.
23. No alcoholic beverages are permitted on range and parking area.
24. You may not shoot on the range after consuming alcoholic beverages or unlawful drugs.
25. All junior members must be under the direct supervision of a parent or an adult.
26. Close and lock the gate when entering or leaving club property.
27. Board of directors must approve all organized shoots.
28. Worn side arms must comply with Pennsylvania State Law.
29. Destruction or mutilation of club property shall be cause for appearance of the Board of Directors for disciplinary action, which may also be cause for arrest and

prosecution. Violators will be responsible to pay for all damages.

30. Any violation of these range rules may be sufficient cause for disciplinary action and or arrest and prosecution.
31. Please keep range and parking areas clean at all times.

Shooting Hours during daylight saving time are Monday thru Saturday 9am to 7pm and Sunday 12pm to 7pm.

Shooting Hours after daylight saving time are Monday thru Saturday 9am to 4pm and Sunday 12pm to 4pm.

Hours are subject to change for scheduled events and work days.
